The objectives of this Malaria Management Policy are to reduce malaria case incidents year on year.

K.A. KWANSA COMPANY LTD goals to achieve this objective by:

- a. Securing and demonstrating leadership commitment.
- b. Assigning clear roles and responsibilities for the management of malaria as a risk.
- c. Assessing needs, defining goals and developing metrics and procedures for monitoring and evaluation malaria management.
- d. Reporting and investigating malaria cases, and sharing lessons learnt.
- e. Having a Steering Committee to manage and regularly review the management of malaria.
- f. Encouraging Contractors to implement comparable malaria management programs

K.A. KWANSA COMPANY LTD will use a systematic approach in the prevention of malaria in each of its operations, the core elements of this approach are:

- a. Awareness, education and knowledge acquisition about malaria.
- b. Bite prevention through the control of mosquito breeding grounds and the use of personal protection measures.
- c. Chemoprophylaxis (anti-malaria medication) to prevent malaria.
- d. Early Diagnosis and immediate response to any case of malaria with prompt treatment using the most effective modalities available.

These core elements are embedded in the Standard Malaria Management and form part of the individual country Malaria Management Plans.

Whilst **K.A. KWANSA COMPANY LTD** will demonstrate visible leadership towards malaria management, everyone has an individual responsibility to contribute to management malaria risk effectively.
